

Learning Skills, Attitudes and Work Habits

- *Seldom (SEL) High level of support required
- *Occasionally (OCC) Moderate support required
- *Often (OFT) Little support required
- *Consistently (CON) Independently

Academic Achievements

- *Percentage Grades and Achievement Scales both indicate a student's demonstration of attitudes, skills and knowledge relative to grade level outcomes as indicated in the Alberta Program of Studies
- *A percentage grade and an achievement scale (see below) is used in core subject areas (English Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies)
- *The Achievement Scale depicted here is used in Physical Education, Health and Option Courses

Limited (L) 0-49%

- *Demonstrates limited performance in relation to the learner outcomes
- *Incomplete understanding of the knowledge and skills at this grade level

Unable to Assess (U)

*There is not enough evidence to communicate student learning

Beginning (B) 50-59%

- *Demonstrates basic performance in relation to the learner outcome
- *Approaching the knowledge and skills at this grade level
- *Applies skills and strategies within highly structured learning situations

Satisfactory (S) 60-74%

- *Demonstrates adequate performance in relation to the learning outcomes
- *Meeting the knowledge and skills at this grade level
- *Applies skills and strategies in familiar learning situations

Proficient (P) 75-89%

- *Demonstrates strong performance in relation to the learner outcomes
- *Solid understanding of knowledge and skills at this grade level
- *Applies skills and strategies in a variety of learning situations

Excelling (E) 90-100%

- *Demonstrates exemplary performance in relation to the learner outcomes
- *Mastery of knowledge and skills at this grade level
- *Applies skills and strategies in new learning situations
