On Thursday, you will be able to view and print your child's Report Card, using PowerSchool. The greatest power in this program is that you can access your child's marks on an ongoing basis, rather than waiting for three times a year to see their progress. The first step, if you are unsure of something, is to "dig into" each course mark by viewing each assignment and its outcomes for more information and this is more effectively done using your computer rather than a smartphone. (Smartphones can only give you a portion of the information.) After you have done this, if there are any questions remaining, please contact your child's teacher.

You don't have to be cold to be cool! It is the time of year that we need to ask for your help to ensure that your child comes to school with appropriate outerwear, especially boots and a warm coat. It is an expectation that our students will go outside twice daily at recess times for some much-needed fresh air and exercise. While a hoodie might be good enough for a dash to a heated vehicle, it can make for a miserable recess now that the temperature is falling. Additionally, does your child have indoor shoes? They often forget to tell their parents that they have outgrown/lost their shoes and, for safety reasons, they need something on their feet inside the building.

Three weeks until Christmas vacation! We know that this is an exciting (and exhausting) time for all of us and we find that if we keep it low key up until the last few days before the holidays, everything seems to go much more smoothly.
