

#### DAIRY QUEEN LUNCH MARCH 24TH





#### DIDSBURY ESSENTIALS FOR OUR COMMUNITY - phone # 403-586-5836

We are a non profit society established in 2014 to serve people in need. 100% of all donations are used to directly benefit people in Didsbury. Each week we hand out groceries, vouchers, milk and egg vouchers, and gas cards. We prepare hot meals and even set up a mini grocery store for folks to pick up items they will use. On average we serve between 70-80 meals every Thursday. Essentials For Our Community also delivers hot meals and food items for families and individuals who are unable to come to our location on Thursday evenings.

These meals are served to individuals, adults, families, teenagers, and children. They are for people who are struggling and need some extra help. Our weekly meals cost between \$350-\$400 and we have 10-15 volunteers per week.100% of all the money raised goes to the program – we are all volunteers – no one is paid!

Tuesday's is coffee time from 9am-11am at the Train Station where people can talk to Sheree the program coordinator and get individual support, gift cards, or just extra help specific for them!
