PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Four weeks until Christmas vacation! We know that this is an exciting (and exhausting) time for all of us. Last year we found that if we kept it low key up until the last few days before the holidays, everything seemed to go much more smoothly. There is lots of learning that needs to happen! Our Leadership Group has some fun activities organized throughout the month but we will be trying to get a lot of work done before we leave for the break. We would encourage you to attend our Band Concert on Dec. 14th - it will be our first in person Christmas Concert since 2018!

Chinook's Edge schools have moved to two **report cards** per year, coinciding with the end of first semester (Jan. 31) and the end of June. Our goal is that parents are able to access this information on an ongoing basis rather than wait for a report card. In case you need help navigating Power School, you can access this four minute tutorial that will help you find the information that you are looking for. The "speech bubble" icon is where you can read the teacher comments about specific outcomes and assignments and this would be what you would have traditionally had to wait for a report card to find out. At the end of each term, please make sure that you access the "Standard Grades Learner Attributes" section as this is where your child's teachers have collaborated to assess their work habits. The comments here are usually very strongly linked to their academic performance. The first step, if you are unsure of something, is to "dig into" each course mark by viewing each assignment and its outcomes for more information - and this is more effectively done using your computer rather than a smartphone. (Smartphones can only give you a portion of the information.) After you have done this, if there are any questions remaining, please contact your child's teacher. As always, if you are unsure of how to log into PowerSchool, please contact the office and Mrs. Mackie will walk you through the process.
